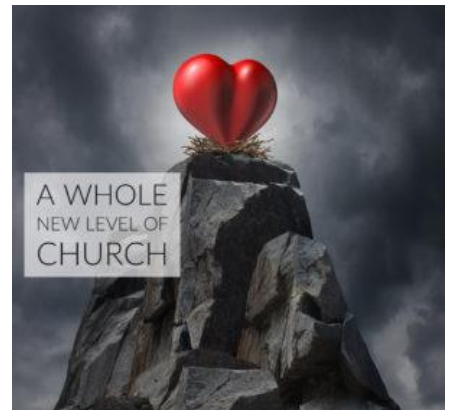


There is a lot of confusion regarding exactly what a “mission-centric” ministry really is and even more regarding the process of transitioning from the minister-centric (Pastor / Flock Model) to a purpose-focused ministry practice. With 9 out of 10 ministries in decline, mission-centric ministry is being seen as a more sustainable and more enjoyable ministry practice.

Transitioning from minister- to mission-centric ministry is a “whole system” process that creates community and organizational coherence. Simply put, in the mission-centric model of ministry, the entire community embodies the *fulfilled state* of the ministry’s purpose. People’s *experience* of the ministry’s mission constitutes the ministry’s identity rather than the minister being the glue that holds everything together.
